I am also grateful that our lovely public library has finally been able to return to its regular hours of operation and is now open on Saturday mornings again. The library has also restarted some of its in-person programming. Tuesday morning Story Time has been very well attended since the beginning of the calendar year, with stories and hands-on activities. Coming up on the library's agenda is the annual Book Sale, Summer Reading, Crafternoon, and computer classes.

The T. Elmer Cox Genealogical and Historical Library is also fully reopened and continues to serve as the epicenter for research about Greene County and its families.
